

GENDER PAY GAP REPORT MARCH 2020

The Aspire Educational Trust is required by law to carry out gender pay gap reporting under the Equality Act 2010(Gender Pay Gap Information) Regulations 2017.

This involves carrying out six calculations that show the difference between the average earnings of men and women in our organisation, but does not involve publishing individual colleagues' data.

We are required to publish the results on our own website and to the government website <https://gender-pay-gap.service.hov.uk/Viewing/search-results>, where the results from other organisations can also be viewed.

We can use these results to assess the levels of gender equality within our Trust, in the relation to the pay balance of male and female employees at different levels.

Gender pay reporting requires us to make calculations based on colleague gender, and their pay during March 2020. We have done this by using our existing payroll records. We have followed the approach to reporting set out in the government guidance.

We believe that men and women are paid equally for doing equivalent jobs across our Multi Academy Trust.

It is clear from the quartile information that our Trust employs more females than males.

The Quartile Table includes the senior leadership team, teaching staff, teaching assistants, administrative staff, premises and maintenance staff including cleaning staff and lunchtime supervisors.

On the snapshot date (31 March 2020) there were 560 employees of which 90.54% were female and 9.46% were male.

The Trust did not pay any bonus during the period.
